Program Recognition-Affiliations, Collaborative Agreements, Partnerships

The Coastal Restoration and Enhancement Through Science and Technology Program (CREST): Southeastern is a charter member of a consortium, the Coastal Restoration and

Enhancement Through Science and Technology (CREST) Program, which was established three years ago. Its members are eleven public and private universities in Louisiana and Mississippi. The consortium functions in partnership with the National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). It is funded through federal appropriations. The Head of the Biology Department is a member of the Executive Committee. Several faculty from the Department have been awarded research funds by CREST over the past two years.

Several faculty from the Department are either conducting research for the Lake Pontchartrain Basin Foundation or are collaborating with Foundation staff members in the drafting of recommendations for the restoration and maintenance of certain habitats, such as cypress swamps. Faculty in the Department are also collaborating with staff from the Lake Pontchartrain Basin Foundation in the establishment of educational workshops that are held at the Turtle Cove Environmental Research Station. The workshops focus on the various factors that impact negatively on the aquatic ecosystems that comprise the Lake Pontchartrain basin.

The Global Wildlife Foundation, located approximately twenty miles from Southeastern, is one of the country's largest wildlife reserves. The Administration and several faculty from the Department are currently in the process of developing a diverse collaborative program with staff members from Global Wildlife. One important aspect of the collaboration would be an opportunity for Biology majors to participate in an Internship program. Several faculty members from the Department will also be involved through specific research projects that would incorporate animals maintained at the reserve.

The Department's Endowed Chair for Environmental Studies is collaborating with staff members of the Nature Conservancy in an effort to determine the factors that regulate biodiversity in pine savannahs that are located on land maintained by the Nature Conservancy. It has also proven to be an educational experience for the students who take classes with Endowed Chair who incorporates the savannahs in his laboratory based classes.

Southeastern and the Department of Biological Sciences has just established a partnership with Tulane University in a unique program designed to provide Southeastern seniors with both undergraduate and graduate credit for courses in Environmental Health that are offered at Tulane. The students will use the courses to help complete their requirements for a B.S. degree in Biological Sciences at Southeastern and for graduate credit toward a M.S. degree in Environmental Health at Tulane. Southeastern faculty will be invited to teach some of the courses in the program and collaborative research opportunities will also be available.

Turtle Cove entered into a Service Learning agreement with Tulane University. Under the agreement, Tulane students interested in service learning credits will assist Turtle Cove Marsh Restoration Coordinator Fred Stouder in marsh restoration activities at the station. Southeastern and Tulane have recently enjoyed an increase in cooperative and collaborative activities. Dr. Moreau's classes in Environmental Management and Environmental Awareness regularly attend the annual Tulane Environmental Conference and other Tulane activities. In return, Tulane students, led by Tulane Environmental Coordinator Dr. Liz Davey, have come to Southeastern to participate in outings at Turtle Cove that include the learning of marsh restoration techniques in the field.

The Endowed Chair for Environmental Science, Dr. Paul Keddy, is collaborating with The Nature Conservancy on ecology and management of rare plant communities at the Lake Ramsey Conservation Area.

A mitigation program led by Michael Greene involving Turtle Cove land on the west end of Jones Island has been initiated with support from several federal agencies. Approximately 10,000 trees were planted in that area last year, primarily through "Alternative Spring Break at Turtle Cove," whereby students from various universities around the country assist in reforestation projects in Manchac Swamp during their spring break period. The project is part of a significant effort by Southeastern to restore cypress swamps in the Lake Pontchartrain basin.

Turtle Cove partnered with the United States Geological Service (USGS) this past year for a new on-line water quality monitoring station for the Pass Manchac area (one of four sites in the Lake Pontchartrain area) that measures 10 different parameters (including stage level and an on-line nitrate monitor) right off of our dock. The instrumentation is housed on the main bulkhead in front of the station overlooking Pass Manchac. The instrument provides on-line readings of 10 different parameters, including stage, water velocity, water temperature, specific conductance, salinity, dissolved oxygen, pH, turbidity and water velocity. Nitrate monitoring will come on line soon. This marks the 3rd such water quality/weather monitoring partnership Turtle Cove has entered into in the past three years (others are with LSU and a LUMCON/TULANE/Southeastern partnership).

Other

Turtle Cove Environmental Research Station remains the centerpiece (facility and equipment use) in the third year of funding for two \$1,000,000 grants provided by EPA to study the Manchac Swamp (Ecology and Restoration Potential of the Manchac Area Wetlands, Phases 1 and 2). Faculty from Southeastern's Biology Department, have--and continue to use--these funds for research projects in and around the Manchac Swamp. In addition to providing access and other resources to researchers, Turtle Cove staff participate in Education and Outreach

components of the grants. Turtle Cove is directly administering a \$53,000 EPA grant that focuses on the outreach component of the EPA sponsored research program. The activities include the establishment of a program website, a written historical narrative of the Manchac swamp, and other outreach initiatives.

As part of the Manchac Project, three teacher workshops were conducted in the summer of 2003 by Dr. Debbie Dardis with assistance from other professionals in the environmental education field in Southeast Louisiana (Moreau, Greene, Lyons, and Maygarden). Number of teachers totaled 38. New projects involving computer/GIS programs and alternative field trips around the LP Basin have been added.

Eight other workshops were held at Turtle Cove during FY 03-04. Seven were Teacher Education Workshops, which totaled 80 teachers. These workshops continue a very successful and long running series that was started by former Turtle Cove Director Robert Hastings in 1991. Since that time, a total of 43 workshops have been held with a total of 443 teachers participating. It is estimated that these workshops have impacted over 200,000 students in the Pontchartrain Basin area schools. Many of the teachers have developed their own "in-service" training programs to teach other teachers, so their impact has been even greater.

As part of the Lake Pontchartrain Restoration Act Program, four teacher workshops were held over the course of a 3-day weekend time frame (two in the spring and two in the fall) in 2003. These workshops were coordinated and instructed by Michael Greene, Turtle Cove's Biologist on Staff and Educational Outreach Coordinator. A total of 42 teachers attended.

Numerous field trips were provided by the Turtle Cove Environmental Research Station. staff for Southeastern and other affiliated universities for research, education and outreach activities. In addition, the K-12 and other group outreach programs remain strong. In summary, 42 different groups consisting of a total of 886 individuals (approximately 1,217 user days) visited the station during the past fiscal year. Thirty different user groups (126 individuals) contributed to approximately 1,207 user days of research activity at Turtle Cove.

INTEGRATED TEACHER PREPARATION

Enhanced by collaborative partnerships with local schools and educational agencies, the Integrated Teacher Preparation Area of Excellence focuses on the needs of preK-12 schools through its innovative beginning and master teacher education programs. Although the Area focuses on regional needs and partnerships, many programs and activities serve as national models for school improvement.
