*Section E. Accommodations for Students with Disabilities*

The mission of the Office of Disability Services is to facilitate the process of academic accommodations for students with disabilities and work in collaboration with other University departments to ensure, where feasible, their full participation in all activities, programs, and services of the University.

It is the student's responsibility to self-identify with the Office of Disability Services, to request accommodations each semester, and to provide their instructor(s) with an accommodation letter from the Office of Disability Services. Medical documentation to substantiate the claim of a disability must be submitted as part of the self-identification process. This is outlined in the publication "Course Accommodations for Students with Disabilities," which is available from the Office of Disability Services.

It is the Faculty's responsibility to maintain the student's confidentiality, provide appropriate accommodations (approved by the Office of Disability Services) in a timely manner either independently or in collaboration with the Office of Disability Services and the Testing Center. Faculty are to maintain the same standards for students with disabilities as are applied to all other students with the exception to accommodations determined by the Office of Disability Services.
